**PROVISIONAL ENROLLMENT***Procedures and Requirements***Immunization**

According to PA Code Title 28 Health and Safety, Chapter 23 School Health, the Administrator/Principal or other designee in charge of nonpublic schools shall ascertain that a student has been immunized in accordance with state requirements prior to admission to school for the first time. Written medical or religious exemption from parents/guardians may be considered for exclusion by the Administrator/Principal or designee in charge.

Students who have not received a vaccine for which a single dose is required may be provisionally admitted to school only if the parents/guardian's plan for completion of the required immunization(s) is part of the student's health record. Student's receiving only partial administration of immunization may be admitted only if the parents/guardian's plan for completion of the required immunization is part of the student's health record. Students shall be considered provisionally enrolled until all requirements have been satisfied to the specification of this policy and/or Administrator/Principal.

**Admission Process**

All students applying to SFCA shall be considered provisionally enrolled until the procedures and requirements of the admission process have been satisfied to the specification of this policy and/or Administrator/Principal.

**International Students**

International students applying for admission to SFCA shall fully complete the procedures and requirements for admission to SFCA and for SEVIS. International students shall comply with immunization requirements. International students shall be considered provisionally enrolled until all requirements have been satisfied to the specifications of this policy and/or Administrator/Principal.
