1. Purpose

It is the intention and desire of the SFCA Board to adopt dress and grooming standards that promote an educational environment based on Biblical principles. Modesty, neatness, and appropriateness are attributes which are expectant of our students in presenting an honoring spirit for the Lord. It is the belief of the Board that the outer appearance reflects the inner reality of our students' relationship with Jesus Christ and their desire to bring honor and glory to Him (I Corinthians 6:19-20).

A defined code of dress and grooming is required for all students attending Seeds of Faith Christian Academy. Teaching students to conform to a standard of dress and grooming is not only a learning opportunity in establishing habits conducive to workforce expectations but also in preparation as ambassadors for Christ.

2. Authority

The Board is intentional in subscribing to a standard of dress and grooming so as to provide guidelines for parents in supporting the manner of dress and grooming required for students and for students to abide by such governance.

3. Delegation  
of  
Responsibility

The Board authorizes the Administrator/Principal or designee to monitor student dress and grooming and enforce the guidelines of this policy to ensure:

1. Modesty, neatness, and appropriateness are harmonious with Biblical principles.
2. Prevention of a hazard to the health, safety, or welfare of students or to others in the school.
3. Avoidance of disruption to the educational environment.

The Administrator/Principal shall impose the necessary restrictions and/or disciplinary measures to those students who are in violation of this policy. In the case of a violation, the Administrator/Principal will, where possible or if necessary:

1. Have the student correct the violation immediately.
2. Contact the student's parent/guardian to assist in the immediate correction of the violation.
3. Contact the student's parent/guardian and have the student removed from the school premises.
4. Segregate the student from the school population for the remainder of the day.

5. Dispense discipline in accordance with the Discipline Code as presented in SFCA Policy 211: Student Discipline.
6. Continued violation of this policy will result in parent/guardian conference and/or discontinued enrollment to SFCA.

Enforcement of this policy is expectant on the cooperation of the student, parent, and school staff to assist in the support and implementation of the guidelines acquainted with dress and grooming.
