

## POLICY ON WHAT CONSTITUTES FAILING A COURSE

A final course grade will be determined by averaging the percentages of the 4 quarters. This final percentage must be 69% or above to pass the class.

In addition to the above, a student will fail a course in the case of any of the following:

- 3 or more failures in the same course over for grading periods
- Failure of a course in the third and fourth grading period.
- Failure of the course during the fourth grading period in addition to failing the final exam

If the student is a senior and they fail a required core course, they will receive zero credit for the course and may not participate in the graduation exercises. The student in this category must complete the course in summer school under their own arrangements, after which time they will be awarded a diploma. Students will not receive a diploma until the required course is completed. Seeds of Faith Christian Academy does not provide summer school courses. It is the student's and parents' responsibility to make arrangements to complete the course during the summer.
